Some of the favorite plot devices in *Star Trek* involve time travel, temporal displacement or alternate timelines. Answer the following questions about *Star Trek* to find out where to go next.

1. A version of the *Starship Enterprise* was sent 22 years into the future, where the Federation and Klingons have been at war for two decades. Put the letter designation of this *Enterprise* in Box 1.


2. In the *Voyager* series finale “Endgame”, a time traveler gets assimilated by the Borg. Use the first letter of that traveler’s rank in Box 2.

3. Quark, Rom and Nog end up crash landing outside this town in 1947. Use the first letter of the town’s name for Box 3.

4. This character from 2063 gets a glimpse of the future in *Star Trek: First Contact* when she sees holodecks, androids, and Borg. Use the second letter in her first name in Box 4.

5. In the *Original Series* episode “The City on the Edge of Forever”, a deranged Dr. McCoy prevents the death of a character played by Joan Collins in 1930’s New York City. Put the first letter of her character’s first name in Box 5.

6. While visiting 23<sup>rd</sup> century Space Station K-7, Odo commented that the extinction of this species must have been a glorious chapter in Klingon history. Use the third letter of the name of this species in Box 6.



7. This steward aboard Captain Archer’s ship was really an agent in the Temporal Cold War, and claimed to be from the 31<sup>st</sup> century. Use the second letter of his first name in Box 7.

8. In *Star Trek IV: The Voyage Home*, Chekov asks a 1986 passerby how to get to Alameda, because he was looking for “\_\_\_\_\_”. Use the first letter of the first word in Box 8.

9. In *The Next Generation* episode “Time’s Arrow”, this is the first character to travel back through the time portal on Devidia II to 1893 San Francisco. Put the first letter of the character’s name in Box 9.
